The Mobile Food Market (MFM) brings healthy, high-quality and affordable food to HRM neighbourhoods facing food-access issues. We get food into the community in three ways: mobile food markets, our Seniors Fresh Food Box program, and our bulk food delivery program.

The Role

There will be a Greeter at the Entrance and at the Exit. At the entrance you'll welcome shoppers and others to the Market. Give basic directions to folks on how to navigate the space, where washrooms are, and answer questions as needed. At the exit, you'll send people on their way, possibly holding doors, giving other information and answering questions.
